

# OCTOBER PRAYER VERSES

Below are the verses for the month of October for you pray over your family and kids. The first 3 days I give an example of how to personalize the verse as a prayer. Fill in the blank with the name of the person you're praying for. The days below are only for weekdays Monday-Friday. I've included the verses straight from the NIV Bible. The days are also divided so you can pray for other needs: 1-the Hurting & Healing, 2-World, 3-Missions, 4-Friends and 5-Community; throughout the month.

Day 2- Matthew 28:20 Give me wisdom to know how to teach [ ] to obey all of the commands you have given us. May he always know that you are with him always, even to the end of the age.

3- John 3:20 May [ ] remember when he's ready to give up and he's lost his strength that you are greater than his feelings and his heart and you know everything that is going on with him.

4- Psalm 100: 4 Guide [ ] to enter into your presence giving thanks to you and praising your name.

5- Matthew 19:26 - Jesus looked at them and said, "With man this is impossible, but with God all things are possible."

6- Psalm 46:5 God is within her, she will not fall; God will help her at break of day.

9- 1 Peter 5:8 Be alert and of sober mind. Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour.

10- Proverbs 4:23 Above all else, guard your heart, for everything you do flows from it.

11- Isaiah 1:17 Learn to do right; seek justice. Defend the oppressed. Take up the cause of the fatherless; plead the case of the widow.

12- Romans 12:21 Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good.

13- Joshua 1:9 Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go.

16- James 1:5 If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to you.

17- Romans 15:13 May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in him, so that you may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.

18- Ephesians 4:32 Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you.

19- 1 Corinthians 15:58 Therefore, my dear brothers and sisters, stand firm. Let nothing move you. Always give yourselves fully to the work of the Lord, because you know that your labor in the Lord is not in vain.

20- Psalm 16:11 You make known to me the path of life; you will fill me with joy in your presence, with eternal pleasures at your right hand.

23- John 1:14 The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the one and only Son, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth.

24- Joshua 24:15 But if serving the Lord seems undesirable to you, then choose for yourselves this day whom you will serve, whether the gods your ancestors served beyond the Euphrates, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land you are living. But as for me and my household, we will serve the Lord.

25- Galatians 3:28 There is neither Jew nor Gentile, neither slave nor free, nor is there male and female, for you are all one in Christ Jesus.

26- Proverbs 10:9 Whoever walks in integrity walks securely, but whoever takes crooked paths will be found out.

27- Colossians 3:14 And over all these virtues put on love, which binds them all together in perfect unity.

30- Ecclesiastes 3:11 He has made everything beautiful in its time. He has also set eternity in the human heart; yet no one can fathom what God has done from beginning to end.

31- Hebrews 4:16 Let us then approach God's throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need.
