February Prayer Verses

1 - Isaiah 40:31 But those who trust in the Lord will find new strength. They will soar high on wings like eagles. They will run and not grow weary. They will walk and not faint.

2 - John 13:34 Love each other. Just as I have loved you, you should love each other.

5 - Jeremiah 31:33 I will put my instructions deep within them, and I will write them on their hearts. I will be their God, and they will be my people.

6 - 2 Corinthians 5:17 This means that anyone who belongs to Christ has become a new person. The old life is gone; a new life has begun!

7 - Philippians 2:3 Don't be selfish; don't try to impress others. Be humble, thinking of others as better than yourselves.

8 - Hebrews 10:24 Let us think of ways to motivate one another to acts of love and good works.

9 - 1 John 3:19 Our actions will show that we belong to the truth, so we will be confident when we stand before God.

12 - Mark 4:20 And the seed that fell on good soil represents those who hear and accept God's word and produce a harvest of thirty, sixty, or even a hundred times as much as had been planted!

13 - Ecclesiastes 3:11 Yet God has made everything beautiful for its own time. He has planted eternity in the human heart, but even so, people cannot see the whole scope of God's work from beginning to end.

14 - 1 John 3:18 Let us not love with words or speech but with actions and in truth.

15 - Ezekiel 36:26 I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit in you; I will remove from you your heart of stone and give you a heart of flesh.

16 - Psalm 118:24 This is the day the Lord has made. We will rejoice and be glad in it.

19 - Zechariah 4:10 Do not despise these small beginnings, for the Lord rejoices to see the work begin...

20 - 2 Corinthians 2:10 Anyone you forgive, I also forgive. And what I have forgiven—if there was anything to forgive—I have forgiven in the sight of Christ for your sake,

21 - Galatians 5:16 So I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh.

22 - Colossians 3:14 And over all these virtues put on love, which binds them all together in perfect unity.

23 - Philippians 4:8 And now, dear brothers and sisters, one final thing. Fix your thoughts on what is true, and honorable, and right, and pure, and lovely, and admirable. Think about things that are excellent and worthy of praise.

26 - Hebrews 13:6 So we say with confidence, "The Lord is my helper; so I will have no fear. What can mere people do to me?"

27 - Hebrews 11:1 Faith shows the reality of what we hope for; it is the evidence of things we cannot see.

28 - John 14:27 Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid.
